

Suggestions

There are different structures used to make suggestions in English. These are the most common:

- **Why don't + we/you/They+ verb in the Infinitive**

Ex: Why don't we go to the cinema?

Why don't they study together?

- **Why doesn't + he/she + Verb in the Infinitive**

Ex. Why doesn't she buy that dress?

- **Would you like +To infinitive?**

Ex: Would you like to have dinner in that new restaurant?

- **Shall I/we+ infinitive?**

Ex: Shall we go to that new restaurant?

- **Let's + verb in the infinitive**

Ex: Let's go to the cinema!

- **What about + Vb ing**

Ex: What about ordering a pizza?

ACCEPTING A SUGGESTION

- Yes, I'd like to.
- Yes, I'd love to.
- What a good idea!
- Why not?
- Yes, with pleasure.

REFUSING A SUGGESTION

- No, let's not.
- No, I'd rather not.

- What an awful / bad idea!
