Advise, allow, ask, beg, cause, enable, encourage, expect, force, help, intend, invite, mean, order, persuade, recommend, remind, take(time), teach, tell, warn Ex: They expected me to pass the driving test.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Advise, persuade, remind, teach, tell, warn + that clause Ex: He taught me that I had to lead a healthier lifestyle. - Recommend + object + that clause: They recommended us to visit the art gallery./ They recommended that we visited the art gallery - Advise, allow, encourage, recommend + - ing (avoiding subject):They recommended visiting the art gallery. <p>2. Arrange, ask, plan, wait + for + object + to-infinitive Ex: we waited for them to arrive</p> <p>3. Want, would like, would love, would prefer, would hate + object + to-infinitive Ex: I would like you to come to my party. NEVER (THAT CLAUSE) ∴I would like that you come....</p>

Let, make, help Ex: She made me do all the washing-up.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Help can be followed by to-infinitive and infinitive without to: They helped me understand / to understand the problem. - Make sb do sth ... in the passive changes to Be made to do sth : I was made to do all the washing-up
T	<p>VERB + OBJECT + GERUND</p> <p>1. Dislike, hate, imagine, involve, keep, mind, prevent, remember, risk, stop Ex: I hate people making noise when eating.</p>
