(no me llames a las ocho. Estaré viendo mi programa favorito)</p> <p><u>This time tomorrow</u> <b>we'll be sitting</b> on the beach. (mañana a esta hora estaremos sentados en la playa)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>At</b> 8 o'clock</li> <li>- At this time tomorrow</li> <li>- <b>Next...</b></li> <li>- <b>On</b> (day )</li> <li>- <b>In the next</b> decade...</li> <li>- <b>This time</b> tomorrow</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>FUTURE PERFECT</b></p>	<p>Will / won't + have + past participle</p> <p>Will + (subject) + have + past part. ....?</p>	<p><b>To say that something will <u>BE FINISHED</u> BY A PARTICULAR TIME IN THE FUTURE.</b></p> <p>Do you think you <b>will have finished</b> it <u>by next Thursday</u>? (¿Crees que lo habrás terminado para el próximo jueves?)</p> <p><u>In five years' time</u> <b>I'll have finished</b> university. ( dentro de cinco años habré terminado la Universidad)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>By ( not later than a particular time) : para</b> By this time next week... By four o'clock By the end of the week/month/year... By then By April</li> <li>- <b>In ( within a period of time)</b> In four months... In two weeks</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS</b></p>	<p>will / won't + have + been + -ing</p> <p>will + subject + have + been + -ing?</p>	<p><b>To express the DURATION OF AN ACTION UP TO A CERTAIN TIME IN THE FUTURE.</b></p> <p><u>By the end of this year</u> <b>she wil have been working</b> here <u>for</u> two years.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>By ( not later than a particular time) : para</b> By this time next week... By four o'clock By the end of the week/month/year... By then By April</li> <li><b>for</b> is used to express the duration of time</li> </ul>
